Conducted January 18-19, 2023

1 Currently Nebraska state senators are term-limited to eight years. Nebraska legislators are proposing to lengthen term limits to 12 years, allowing themselves to stay in office four years longer. Do you favor or oppose a change in Nebraska term limits that would lengthen term limits from 8 years to 12 years?*

- 8% Strongly favor
- 13% Somewhat favor
- 18% Somewhat oppose
- 52% Strongly oppose
- 10% Not sure

2 Which is more likely - that Nebraska state legislators want longer term limits to benefit the people of Nebraska, or that they want longer term limits to benefit themselves personally?*

- 13% To benefit the people of Nebraska
- 71% To benefit themselves personally
- 16% Not sure

3 Are you more or less likely to support a Nebraska state legislator who votes to lengthen his or her own term limits?*

- 4% Much more likely
- 5% Somewhat more likely
- 17% Somewhat less likely
- 47% Much less likely
- 15% No impact
- 11% Not sure

4 Do you favor or oppose creating term limits for county commissioners, city council members, school boards, and all other local officials in Nebraska?*

42%	Strongly favor
29%	Somewhat favor
11%	Somewhat oppose
7%	Strongly oppose
10%	Not sure

Methodology

The survey of 650 Registered Voters was conducted for LIF on January 18-19, 2023. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.8 percentage points.
